We have some exciting developments in the pipeline which includes the possible construction of a closed road cycle track. This proposed 1km road, void of any traffic, will provide a safe environment for both the recreational cyclist and elite road racers. Further in the future, there is the possibility of resurfacing the tennis and netball courts to create yet another facility that will be available for our community.

We can cater for large or small numbers and will deliver this free within a radius of 4 miles. New College Community Partnership Development Team

The Community Partnership Development team is responsible for setting up and monitoring a wide range of projects including Mentoring and Paired Reading at the college.

The team runs a number of volunteering opportunities for our local community ranging, from an hour a week on our paired reading project to classroom placements for one or two days a week. We are particularly keen to offer placements to members of the local community seeking to gain experience to help them to change jobs or to return to work. The college is very proud of our paired reading project and we have a dedicated team of over 30 community volunteers who come into college for an hour a week to work with students.

We are particularly keen to develop our allotment project and are hoping to work more closely with various community projects. At the moment we have a group of local adults working two days a week in our allotment area. If you are interested in helping us to run our community allotment then contact any of the team. The sessions run on Monday and Thursday starting at 10.15 am until 2.30 pm.

We continue to work with the Prince's Trust and other organisations such as Telefonica and University of Leicester. We also have particularly strong links with the Square Mile Programme at De Montfort University. Undergraduates help us with both paired reading and mentoring projects. We also have university students volunteering in classrooms working alongside teachers to provide additional support to enhance the learning experiences of our own students. University students also run a variety of other projects including a dance club, magazine club, poetry experience, volleyball club, the list goes on! Last academic year we had over 140 volunteers working at the college in a variety of capacities.

The Gymnastics Centre New College Leicester

The Gymnastics Centre in the college was built as a partnership project between New College Leicester, Hinckley Gymnastics Club, Sport England and British Gymnastics (National Governing Body of Gymnastics and Trampoline in Great Britain).



New College Gymnastics Centre is one of several venues specialising in gymnastic activities managed by Hinckley Gymnastics Club. The club was founded in Charles Keene College in Leicester and extended its services to the Leisure Centre Hinckley in 1978 then into the UK's first self build dedicated safety pit training facility at Clarendon Park Hinckley. With classes across the county the club delivers an exceptional, Award Winning, community provision from recreation to Elite performance (Commonwealth and International medals), a Disability regional hub, Street Games Doorstep Clubs and running up to 50 spectator events a year in the college.

At New College Leicester, members can enjoy a range of classes and activities that gather up all the skills and challenges of acrobatic, fitness and competitive performance.

PRE SCHOOL every Friday 1-2 pm at Clarendon Park Hinckley.

RECREATION GYMNASTICS a wide range of classes at New College Leicester, Elizabeth Woodville, Hinckley Clarendon and Beaumont Leys School.

FOUNDATION GYMNASTICS at New College Leicester, Elizabeth Woodville, Hinckley Clarendon and Beaumont Leys.





DEVELOPMENT AND COMPETITIVE TRAINING at New College Leicester and Clarendon Hinckley. Out of this relatively small club, 37 International gymnasts have emerged, a European champion, National Champions in GB, England, Scotland and Wales. Classes are by audition with strict targets and age related skills. For a sport career in gymnastics this is the way to go but it requires great dedication and commitment. Ages 5 to 25.

MY CLUB GYMNASTICS these classes look at all gymnastics apparatus, Team Gym, display gymnastics and Gymnastics For All where students are allowed to drive the activities and help to plan their program. Ages 11-18. Fully qualified staff assist in developing students personal interests.

DISABILITY GYMNASTICS a new venture for the club with dedicated classes for Autistic students, students with learning difficulties and physical challenges. The club hosts Disability Gymnastics seminars and taster sessions and runs 2 competitions each year. The club assists in the management of Down Syndrome championships, national and International.

FREESTYLE GYMNASTICS a collection of classes which gather up anything that goes upside down. With one of the best urban environment indoor apparatus set ups, the club can build a landscape in the gym that will challenge any freerunner, acrobat or Traceur (parkour). Students are very much self driven with the club offering specialist help in technical and safety matters. The club hosts the Parkour Academy affiliated to Parkour UK.

STREET GAMES We have Doorstep Clubs in Clarendon Hinckley (Mon, Thurs and Sat) and at New College Leicester every Monday. Ages progress across the evening from 5pm for under 14 to adults at 8pm, This class gathers up many interests for young people and adults in gymnastics, free running, B Boy, street dance, theatre, military, street workout and cheer.

ADULT TUMBLE for those who have seen TV TUMBLE or who have been gymnasts in the past or perhaps just want to try a more dynamic fitness program. Classes have all ages 18+ in groups with staff who assist in learning a variety of activities. A very social and friendly class, Monday and Thursday 8pm – 9pm.


British Cycling qualified coaches lead all sessions, currently running fortnightly, on Monday evenings, 6.15 - 7.45pm, throughout the year.

Coaching sessions typically comprise safety checks, basic cycling skills, bike-handling exercises, games, races, and FUN, all at an appropriate level to suit all age groups. We now have young cyclists regularly taking part in competitions at Mallory Park and Prestwold, not without success.

But, it is not all about racing. Good fun, team spirit, and healthier lifestyles are just as important to us, as well as an opportunity to meet and make new friends.

With the skills acquired at the New College Leicester Go-Ride coaching sessions, young cyclists can go on to participate in the whole range of cycling activities. Leicester Riders Basketball Club



Leicester Riders have been working in partnership with New College Leicester for a number of years now and the partnership has grown in stature over the last 18 months.

We are looking to launch a new element to the very successful Shoot to The Future programme which enters its 4th year with the college but to link into Street Games and promote a new Doorstep Club on a Friday Night. With Basketball being offered to the participants but also to look at a Street Dance session as well as interact with Football run by CPP on Friday evenings too! We are hoping to offer a variety of street workshops in conjunction with Street Games and the Local police to address the young person needs. It is important for us to engage and use sport as a vehicle to gather insight on how to help them through the many challenges that they may be facing.

This year also saw New College Leicester host our National League teams and brought in many people to see the facility and support the local teams. Again we have just held trials for our National league teams and we are pleased to see many local young people attending and some of them are students at the college breaking through into our National League U14 and U16 boys squads. We are grateful for being able to train and play out of this great facility.





In May 2015 we saw Riders pilot a launch of the Primary School Central Venue League which saw the college's partner primary schools take part in 4 weeks of Basketball competition and was hugely successful. We saw over 50 primary aged players competing from Stokes Wood, Hope Hamilton, Spinney Hill, Abbey and Northfield House. It is hoped that Riders will run a similar competition through the coming season linking into the School Games organisation too. This was useful for training and giving volunteers experience of running an event and mini-league to organise and oversee on the day.

Riders also continue to provide support to the college via offering an After-School Club which will hopefully grow and support a Satellite Club session. Riders are very proud to promote all of the basketball sessions at New College Leicester and have also looked at a mentoring programme from all of our programmes that are hosted at the college. It is important that we continue to recruit volunteers into our network.

Riders were able to run 4 weeks of Masterclass Coaching and from the success of this we will be launching a Coaching Academy linked to our Talent Performance strategy and look at training our keen parents and volunteers and young inexperienced coaches to run sessions across the season to share and learn from each other. From this we are now looking at launching a Coaching Academy which will be open to existing and new coaches/teachers/parents wanting to learn more about the game and become enthused by what becoming a coach can achieve. We will see this return this year and is already receiving applicants from across the Country. The Leicester Riders look forward to seeing the partnership develop further and providing the New College students and young people in the community more positive opportunities.



Leicester City Girls Centre of Excellence



Leicester City Girls' Centre of Excellence sits within the FA's Talent ID Pathway which seeks to develop players from grassroots clubs and the school curriculum level,

through to Community Football and the Tesco Skills Programme, on to affiliated clubs, and then moving up to the Centres of Excellence before finally progressing on to women's senior football and ultimately on to England international level.

Our Centre of Excellence has solid foundations, having been established in 1999 and being one of the first Centres to gain a licence from the FA to develop young talented female footballers in the next step up from school and club football into a professional football environment. There were previously 52 Centres of Excellence in the UK but the number of successful licence applications reduced to 28 following a stringent new Application and Review process.

We believe that talent at all levels should be nurtured and that we should make concerted efforts to raise the profile of girls' football so that our elite players not only receive the recognition they deserve, but also become strong role models for girls' participation in all sport across Leicestershire.


