Job Description

We are looking for **Holiday Activity Leader's** to join our team over the summer half term delivering on the **Holiday Activity & Food Programme**.

Molly's Gift have been delivering Holiday Activity & Food Programmes since 2021 for primary aged children, expanding to secondary aged children in 2023. We are always looking to expand to provide as many provisions across the local area as possible.

The ideal candidate will have a **passion for working with young people**, creating a fun & engaging setting for all children, specifically those from disadvantaged backgrounds.

The role will include leading on a range of enriching activities throughout the Summer, including trips out. You will lead sessions as organised by the Holiday Activity Co-Ordinator and assist in the delivery of a smooth and efficient programme for children and young people.

Responsibilities:

- Lead on various activities for children and young people throughout the day, as advised by the Holiday Activity Co-Ordinator.
- Encourage participation in activities and provide feedback to the Holiday Activity Co-Ordinator.
- Support the Holiday Activity Co-Ordinator in the planning and implementation of activities, providing idea's/suggestions for activities.
- Ensure that all activities are conducted in a safe and secure environment, whilst keeping to the time scales of that day.
- Assist with lunch times, ensuring all children and young people are provided with a healthy meal.
- Organise groups efficiently during outings/trips.
- Take responsibility for any safeguarding and safety concerns, ensuring they are reported appropriately to the DSL.

Previous experience working with children and young people and leading a session is **desirable**, though not essential.

A fully enhanced DBS is essential. We will provide this if you do not already have a recent one.

The role will be on a zero-hour basis, starting with the 6 week Summer half term, with up to 30 hours a week available. If successful, there will be other opportunities for casual work within other Molly's Gifts projects, including Saturday Club and other half term camps across the year.
